#### **Safety Smart Ambassadors**

A number of coaches have reserved their \$500 travel stipends and participants are beginning their scholarship applications. Make sure your team enjoys the benefits of being Safety Smart Ambassadors.

## **Video Challenge**

Teams may upload their videos now. YouTube views begin to be counted TODAY through March 31. Please complete the <u>LifeSmarts Video Challenge Submission Form</u> this week. Judges will begin reviewing videos March 18. Video length is preferred to be 75-90 seconds, but teams will not be marked down for videos ranging from 55-90 seconds due to an inconsistency with one published rubric.

### **Excursions**

Your team has the choice of two excursions this year. *Both are free of charge* to team members and coaches. Your team will choose just one to attend together. ## Tour the US Mint

- Touring the United States Mint is a fascinating experience for all ages and one to remember for a lifetime. Tours cover the present state of coin manufacturing and the history of the Mint. Visitors learn about the craftsmanship required at all stages of the minting process from the original designs and sculptures to the actual striking of the coins. Today, the Denver Mint's output can exceed 50 million coins a day.
- Tours last approximately 45 minutes. The Mint is within walking distance from the hotel and the 16<sup>th</sup> street mall. We encourage you to use the rest of the afternoon to explore everything the downtown area has to offer!

- Visit Dinosaur Ridge
  - Dinosaur Ridge is located in Morrison, Colorado, just west of Denver, and is one of the world's most famous dinosaur fossil localities. In 1877, some of the best-known dinosaurs were first discovered by Arthur Lakes, a professor at the Colorado School of Mines in Golden. These included *Apatosaurus*, *Stegosaurus*, and *Allosaurus*. These specimens represent animals that lived 150 million years ago in the Late Jurassic Period, also known as the "Age of Giants."
  - The general Dinosaur Ridge guided tour consists of four sites, each with about 20 minutes of interpretation by your guide. Sites include:
    - The Swamp Site
    - The Dinosaur Tracksite: 300 footprints left by several dinosaurs and one crocodile
    - Brontosaur Bulges: Tracks made next to a watering hole by some of the largest dinosaurs to ever live
    - The Dinosaur Bone Quarry: Dinosaur bones imbedded in sandstone that was originally left as sand in an ancient stream system
  - There is room for 110 on this excursion, and transportation will be provided.
