# **OTC Public Service Announcement Activity**

## **Description:**

Participants will review and share what they learned about OTC medicine safety by creating a Public Service Announcement.

### Time:

10 minutes planning; 30 seconds/1 minute per group for presenting

### **Materials:**

- OTC Medicine Safety vocabulary handout
- Poster board/large paper, markers
- Empty OTC package for each group

### **Procedures:**

- 1. Explain the concept of a public service announcement.
  - a. A public service announcement (PSA) is a message from a not-for-profit organization to raise awareness or provide information about an issue via mass media.
- 2. Divide participants into small groups.
- 3. Write the following OTC medicine safety topics on separate slips of paper:
  - a. Proper OTC storage
  - b. Unsafe medication handling
  - c. Drug Facts label
- 4. Ask each group to select a category.
- 5. Allow 10 minutes for teams to create a commercial, jingle, rap, radio ad, etc., using content vocabulary, which explains their topic to the rest of the group. PSAs should be no more than one minute in length.
- 6. Groups present their messages to one another.
