 - Second place teams have one week after their state competition is held to submit an application, but they must submit by March 1, 2021, if that is first.

 - Twelve teams qualified for the FBLA National Leadership Conference this summer.
 - 125 teams registered and competed, 85 qualified to advance to NLC
 - The FBLA / LifeSmarts Spring Challenge will take place February 1-26, 2021.
 - FCCLA 16 teams qualified for FCCLA/LifeSmarts Knowledge Bowl at the
 National Leadership Conference to be held this coming summer.
 - These teams have not been announced publicly yet. FCCLA will announce them on December 11.

 - Officials may be comfortable using their computer without printing the document

- High points Volunteer roles, familiarity with zoom platform, recommended
- A few adjustments have already been made just wordsmithing, really.
- Other items to come for virtual live competitions will be a LifeSmarts competitors info letter for teams (coaches and students); Info on pre-assigning participants to Zoom rooms; Room co-host orientation script; Room host orientation script; and a short QuizBowl Pro video orientation
- What else do you think is need for those of you using this format for your state competitions?
- Other Competition materials such as the script are being developed and will be shared with you once ready.
- As a reminder there are four ways to go for your state competition. Any of these is totally fine! We know things may have to change and we can work with that. If possible, we need to know your plans by January 15 so that we can avoid too many events on the same day.
 - Choice 1: In-person state competition
 - Choice 2: Virtual competition held live online (Zoom and QuizBowl pro)
 - Choice 3: State TeamSmarts assessment determines winner (State Championship online test)
 - Choice 4: Team scores determine winner (five category quizzes and capstone scores are averaged for top four team members for team score)
- Communicating with your coaches is key!

Nationals Planning

- We have been planning for both in-person and virtual
- We will make the decision sometime around mid-January and will share it broadly immediately
- Survey going out to all coaches soon. We want and need their input. We will consider best schedule for the competition and what time they would be able to devote to this.
- 2020 teams will get an email from us asking their plans for the 2020 championship soon. We will ask them to commit in January
 - Tammie recommends contacting 2020 teams after we have made a decision on in-person or virtual event
