We'll start with the Individual Questions. I will ask a multiple-choice question and four short answer fact questions to each player. We will go in order by category. When it is your turn, you are the only person who may answer and you may not consult with your team members. If you do not know an answer please say "pass" and I will read the next question. You have one minute to respond to all five questions in your topic. Each correct answer is worth 5 points.

After the Individual Questions we will move to the Team Questions. Here you may confer and anyone on the team may answer. Please raise your hand to be called on if you wish to answer. You have 10 seconds to provide an answer, and each correct answer is worth 10 points. There are 16 questions in the Team round.

As a reminder, we ask that you keep the questions used in this team interview confidential, and do not share them beyond your team at any time.
