Participants: High-achieving high school students represent their states to compete for the national title. Adult volunteers ensure exciting and fair competitions.

Background: LifeSmarts is an educational program and scholarship opportunity hosted by the National Consumers League to develop the consumer and marketplace skills of teens in a meaningful and fun way. High school students begin online, and top-scoring teams advance to the state level. State champion teams compete in a variety of formats for the annual championship title.

Volunteers: Volunteers serve as Question Masters who interact with students and ask questions in live competition, as Judges who work as a panel to determine whether answers provided by students are correct, and in other roles.
