4 minutes	<p>Introductions</p> <p>Opening Questions to the participants</p>	<p>Prompts to introduce the team: What is a LifeSmarts Privacy and Security mentor? Who are we? Say something fun about yourselves to relax your audience or tell a social media story.</p> <p>What are the differences between private and secret? Is private information always secret?</p>	
6 minutes	1. Content Vocabulary, JV	Distribute or post the Basic Content Vocabulary List. Prompt: Today we are going to review and learn some terms that you should know if you use social media.	

		Give a few minutes for participants to read the list, then briefly describe the terms, adding examples that are common for their age group.

	FishBowl	Prompt: We are going to play a game to help learn some facts about the privacy and security measures you should use or be aware of. Read game directions	FishBowl Directions Large glass bowl filled with individual FishBowl questions
	Agree, Disagree, Maybe If...	Prompt: Let's explore what you know and think about privacy and security. Why do you think this is important to understand? Read game directions OR ask participants to complete the worksheet and then conduct a discussion, including the information in the Discussion Prompt sheet. 	Video: "Your Digital Footprint"	Prompt: When you use social media it is your job to manage and care for your digital identity. This short video talks about being careful about what you share online.	Video URL:
