\$30,000 provides scholarships for a complete program year for all teams.

\$15,000 provides scholarships for 1st and 2nd place teams; \$10,000 provides scholarships for 3rd and 4th place teams; \$5,000 provides scholarships for individual winners and prizes for top individuals and teams.
