Background:

LifeSmarts is an educational program and scholarship opportunity hosted by the National Consumers League to develop the consumer and marketplace skills of teens in a meaningful and fun way. High school students begin online, and topscoring teams advance to the state level. State champion and wild card teams compete in a variety of formats for the annual championship title.

Volunteers:

Volunteers serve as question masters who interact with students and ask questions in live competitions. They also serve as judges who work as a panel to determine whether answers provided by students are correct. They take on other roles, as needed.
