National LifeSmarts Championship 2024: Edition 2 Information for Coaches & Teams Focus: Deadlines, attire, scholarship, pin swap and more!

Dear Coaches and Team members,

We are so excited to see you San Diego, April 18 – 21, 2024 competing in the 30<sup>th</sup> National LifeSmarts Championship! Each week leading into Nationals, we will share special updates with you through this <u>San Diego Celebration Central</u> newsletter. Our hope is that this will assist you and your team in preparing for Nationals by providing helpful information, timely updates and reminders.



**2024 State Confirmation Form and Reservation Numbers** – Very important! This form is due **two weeks** following notification of your LifeSmarts National Championship invitation. This form assures us that you will be attending and competing in the National LifeSmarts Championship and also allows us to invite the second- place team in your state to attend and compete if your team cannot. *Several teams who were named State Champions more than two weeks ago have not sent in these form as of this morning.* 

# Team registration due by March 15

*To help us in planning and confirming numbers, please register as soon as you can!* You must complete the online registration form for the 2024 National LifeSmarts Championship to confirm your team's place at the championship. <u>The deadline is March 15, 2024</u>. Please visit this <u>link</u> to register yourself and your team.

If you have an assistant coach, they must already be registered and associated with your team at <u>https://lifesmarts.org/</u>. Let us know if you have any problems with that.

Coaches, you must indicate which *Individual Assessment* should be assigned to each student on your team. If a student has competed in the National LifeSmarts Championship before (whether

in-person or virtually), they may not repeat Individual Assessment topics they have previously tested on.

The registration form also requests your room confirmation numbers. If you don't have these when registering, please email them to Ryan at <u>Ryanb@nclnet.org</u> within two days of registering and also provide them on the <u>2024 State Confirmation Form and Reservation</u> <u>Numbers</u> mentioned above.

# Team social media photos due by March 15 – Please send ASAP!

## Reminder about Guests:

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The National LifeSmarts Championship is a **closed** event. Teams and coaches have earned their right to be here. Only registered coaches/ assistant coaches, competitors, alumni volunteers, adult volunteers, sponsors, state coordinators, LEAP members, and the LifeSmarts/ NCL/ Conference team are allowed to participate. Admission to all LifeSmarts events will be monitored.

We have received many questions about parents observing. Should parents be traveling in the area, they are only able to observe the buzzer matches that their child is competing in. They may not attend any other events (provided meals, Sister team activity, SpeedSmarts, Pool party and dance, Opening ceremonies, Sweet 16 announcement or Awards programs). ## Sarah Weinberg Memorial Scholarship – Due March 15

Coaches may nominate one graduating Senior for the Sarah Weinberg LifeSmarts Memorial Scholarship. This scholarship is awarded annually to a LifeSmarts participant who demonstrates a commitment to volunteer service work, like Sarah did. Scholarship nominations are due March 15. ## Questions about team attire

We have had several questions about attire for the National LifeSmarts Championship. There is no required attire. Here are a few suggestions based on what we have observed in the past few years.

Many teams choose to match. Many teams don't. It is totally up to you and your team!

- For Team photos and Competition 3 (Sister Teams Activity) Team T-shirts and jeans or khakis. It is always fun to remember you are representing your school, organization and/or state in any of the photos and the competitions. You can also wear or bring small props to represent your school or favorite sports team or university in the team photos. We have signs for our student leadership organizations and LifeSmarts sponsors to be used in photos as well.
- Competitions 4 6: Polo style shirts and khakis or jeans.
- Competition 7 and 8: Polo style shirts and khakis or jeans.
- Semi-Final and Finals: Nice shirts and dress pants or khakis with or without coat and tie; Dresses or nice shirt and slacks or skirt.

Immediately following dinner on Thursday evening, the Pin Swap provides time for exchanging pins, buttons, stickers, or anything representative of your state with other LifeSmarts competitors. Our LEAP panel will also be leading icebreakers and games so that everyone can have fun and get to know others as well as their sister team. Each student can also get their LifeSmarts icon badge for the Individual Topic Assessment they completed during the pin trade. While pin trading is optional, it is a fun way to meet and get to know friends from all over the country. Look for free items that represent your state, city or town, or your school or club. Local

clubs, banks, businesses, Chambers of Commerce, and state welcome centers may be able to help you with swap items. You may also make an item to represent your town, school, club or state to trade! (Below are a few examples of items.)


