Background:	LifeSmarts is an educational program and scholarship opportunity hosted by the National Consumers League to develop the consumer and marketplace skills of teens in a meaningful and fun way. High school students begin online, and topscoring teams advance to the state level. State champion, wild card, and sweepstakes teams compete in a variety of formats for the annual varsity championship title.
Volunteers:	Volunteers fill many vital roles including serving on a panel of expert judges to determine whether answers provided by competitors are correct; serving as question masters who interact with students and ask questions in the live competitions; serving as facilitators and judges for the SpeedSmarts interactive competition; and staffing other important roles throughout the event.
