
Program Updates

In September, LifeSmarts also:

1. Welcomed more than 80 teams that competed in the FCCLA/LifeSmarts Knowledge Bowl online quiz. We will meet the top 40 teams in Birmingham, AL, next month at the FCCLA Fall Conference where the teams will compete over two days to advance to next summer's

FCCLA National Leadership Conference.

- 2. Announced the 2023-24 Norton Wild Card opportunity for under-resourced teams and Title 1 school teams to join us in San Diego next April. Teams who are selected as Norton Wild Card teams receive a travel stipend to help offset their costs to attend the event. LifeSmarts staff and state coordinators work closely with Norton teams to ensure that they feel prepared to compete.
- 3. Added more than 1,000 new LifeSmarts questions to the competition database this year. We have more than 45,000 questions available for live competitions and online quizzes.
