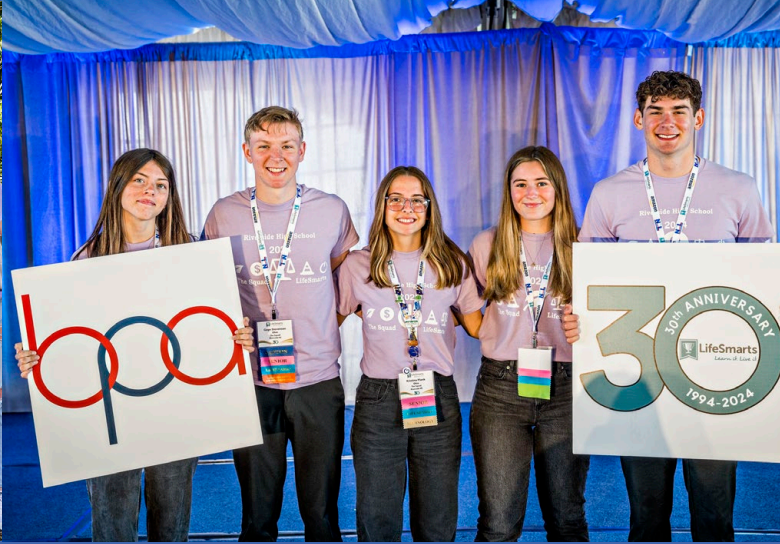

The BPA LifeSmarts competition begins with the online challenges, with top-scoring teams receiving cash prizes. Teams of two BPA members pair up to compete as a team. See below for more details.

Challenge Rules

A team member cannot be on more than one BPA team.

Teams may compete in both challenges but may choose to compete in just one of the two.

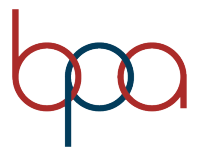
A chapter may have any number of teams compete.

The teams that earn the highest score in each challenge will receive cash prizes. One Junior Varsity level BPA Team comprised of two members in grades 6-8, and one Varsity level BPA team comprised of two members in grades 9-12 will be recognized in each challenge.

Steps to register and compete

- 1 The chapter adviser registers online as a coach. (Coaches only need to [register](#) once.)
- 2 Students [register](#).
- 3 The coach creates a team. The names should include the school and students' names, ex: "Centennial_Smith_Jones." Choose "BPA" as team type.
- 4 The coach adds two students and designates one as captain.
- 5 Students use practice quizzes and other online resources.
- 6 Students will take one quiz together before midnight (ET) on the final day of the respective challenge.
- 7 The quiz will be assigned to the team captain. The captain logs in and clicks on the quizzes tab on the left, then the folder name of the quiz they are taking.
- 8 After the completion of each challenge, LifeSmarts and BPA will announce the winning teams and award their prizes.
